

Short-Term Case Management

Short-term case management provides brief, office-based, community or virtual care coordination services to help address short-term barriers in independent living and access community resources.

SCHEDULES

Springfield (710 N. Eighth St.)

Virtual care and in-person appointments available Monday through Friday.

For clients needing transportation or community-based needs:

- All day on Tuesdays and Thursdays by appointment only
- O Transportation available if needed, but will be determined on a case-by-case basis

Logan and Mason Counties (515 N. College St. | Lincoln)

Virtual Care and in-person appointments available Monday, Wednesday and Thursday.

EXAMPLES OF SHORT-TERM CASE MANAGEMENT NEEDS

(not to exceed 2-5 appointments)

- Assistance with enrolling for benefits
- Food insecurity; assistance with accessing food pantries for the first time
- Assistance with applying for disability (initial application, not appealing)
- Assistance with resume
- Assistance with applying for jobs
- Assistance with obtaining IDs (birth certificate, Social Security card, etc.)

- Assistance with obtaining a free government phone
- Assistance with obtaining transportation (bus, Medicaid rides, etc.)
- Assistance with applying for utilities
- Assistance with brief housing needs, applying for section 8/HUD
- Assistance with obtaining in-home caregiver services
