



The Dr. George Ferry Memorial Scholarship

Two \$2,500 (nonrenewable) scholarships are awarded each spring to Taylorville High School graduates planning a career in healthcare. The family of Dr. George Ferry and Taylorville Memorial Foundation administer these scholarships.

Criteria

- Minimum of a 3.0 grade point average
- Minimum of two years of life sciences at THS, including Introduction to Human Anatomy and Physiology
- Minimum of two years of physical sciences at THS, including Chemistry
- Acceptance to a two- or four-year college or university with a major in a healthcare field
- Written essay of 275–300 words, 1–2 pages, size 12 font, typed and double spaced on: *“What healthcare career have you chosen, what do you hope to accomplish and what has influenced your decision?”*

Materials Required for Application

1. Completed application
2. Class rank, GPA and ACT score
3. Transcript from THS
4. Two letters of recommendation
5. College or university chosen with proof of enrollment (*Copy of acceptance letter or copy of fall class schedule*)
6. Designated field of study
7. Essay
