

Emergency Medical Services

- The subsequent slides outline the process for license renewal of the following licenses:
 - Emergency Medical Technician (EMT-B, A-EMT/ EMT-I, Paramedic)
 - Lead Instructor
 - Emergency Communications Registered Nurse
 - Emergency Dispatcher
 - EMR
 - Pre-Hospital Registered Nurse

- It is of the upmost importance that IDPH has your correct address on file.
 - If you need to change your address, you can do so through this webpage:

IDPH Address Change

- Approximately 60 days prior to the expiration of your license, IDPH will mail a letter to your address listed on file. This form will contain a PIN number and website address.
- Log onto the website and use your PIN number to
 - Pay renewal fees (listed on next slide)
 - Credit or debit card required
 - Declare child support status
 - Declare felony conviction status
- Print Confirmation Page to forward to EMS Office along with continuing education.
- Mailing the paper version w/ payment to IDPH can be done but will take longer. Forward copy to EMS Office.

- Renewal Fees Fees range from \$20-\$40
 - Complete fee schedule available through this webpage

 Volunteers serving an area of less than 5,000 population, members of Illinois National Guard and Illinois State Police can apply for a waiver of the fee through this webpage:

EMS License Fee Waiver

- Allow extra time if you apply for this
- Submit the completed form to the EMS Office as soon as possible.

- Forward the Confirmation Page, current CPR card and CE hour documentation to EMS Coordinator prior to expiration date. In four years, the following are required.
 - -EMT-B = 60 hours
 - -EMT-I = 80 hours
 - -EMT-P = 100 hours
 - Lead Instructor = 40 hours*
 - Emergency Communications RN = 32 hours
 - Emergency Dispatcher = 48 hours
 - First Responder = 24 hours
 - Pre-Hospital RN = 100 hours

Region 3 Renewal Requirements

- Documentation Required
 - CPR for Healthcare Provider
- A-EMT/EMT-I/ Paramedic/ PHRN/ ECRN
 - ACLS
 - PHTLS (TECC- after initial PHTLS), ITLS, TNS or TNCC
 - PEPP, PALS or ENPC
- Additional Information/ Requirements
 - Lead Instructor 20 hours content education/ 20 hours instructor education
 - ECRN 32 hours Con Ed
 - EMD 48 hours Con Ed

- Continuing education hours
 - 25% must be within Memorial EMS System
 - No more than 25% from clinical experience (off duty)
 - No more than 50% from instruction (2 hours = 1CE hour)
 - Up to 75% can be under one training site code
 - Internet Sites must have IDPH or CAPCE approval

EMS Extension Request Application

- Extensions have a late fee of \$50.00

- After Licensee has completed online requirements
 AND
- Forwarded correct Con Ed documentation to the EMS Office
 - Confirm receipt by EMS Office
- Renewals are processed multiple times a month
- Licenses are active as soon as both renewal pieces are completed.
