How to get results LabCorp (PCR test)

If your sample was sent to LabCorp, you will be able to access your results through the LabCorp Patient Portal (A) or the LabCorp App (B).

If your test is POSITIVE:

- Isolate.
- Your local health department will contact you in the next week. If you are doing well, the health department will likely stop your isolation and release you to work/school on day 11 (day 0 is the first day of symptoms).
- Contact anyone you were close to since starting symptoms, including 48 hours before symptoms started.
- Your household members and close contacts need to start quarantine (stay home unless seeking medical care or testing) for 10–14 days. Your quarantine time will be based on your county guidelines. The 10–14 day quarantine starts on the **last day** around the positive person with COVID-19.
- Call your primary care physician with any questions.
- Call 911 or seek emergency help if you experience any moderate-severe chest pain or shortness of breath.

If your test is NEGATIVE:

- Even with your negative test result, if you had exposure to someone with COVID-19 (>15 min throughout the day, less than 6 feet) or a household member is positive or symptomatic, please stay home under quarantine if you are not fully vaccinated. If you are fully vaccinated, you do not need to quarantine with a negative PCR test and resolved symptoms. A mask in public and/or periodic testing is recommended if vaccinated and exposed.
- Retesting is recommended if symptoms continue or worsen, especially if you lose your taste or smell.
- Call your primary care physician with any questions.
