- 1. Candidates have 3 attempts to pass the exam within 12 months after initial authorizations to test.
- 2. After 3 FAILED ATTEMPTS this requires remedial training before approval for additional attempts.

- 3. After the remedial training, the candidate must submit their documentation to support@nremt.org, along with their application ID number.

 - b. please do not upload remedial training until all three failed attempts have been taken, or it could shorten the number of total attempts allowed.
- 4. Once the candidate has successfully passed the NREMT exam they will email their pass results to their course instructor. Instructor will forward to the EMS System.
- 5. EMSSC will complete a T-card packet (Transaction card, personal history statement, CPR card, and copy of successful completion of the NREMT) and submit to IDPH for the license to be created.
