We are a team of mental health professionals and peers who provide behavioral health support to individuals of all ages who are experiencing a mental health crisis within Cass, Christian, Logan, Mason, Menard, Morgan, Sangamon and Scott counties.



MOBILE CRISIS RESPONSE

Mobile Crisis Response (MCR) provides crisis de-escalation and intervention within the community setting, 24/7. Our team is made up of clinicians trained in verbal de-escalation, conflict resolution, suicide prevention and safety planning.

MCR clinicians provide a combination of face-toface and telehealth evaluations of clients. Their goal is to resolve the crisis in the community.

MCR will make referrals to outpatient services or make recommendations for inpatient psychiatric hospitalization when needed. MCR also offers post-crisis follow-up, including peer support, to ensure continued aid after the crisis.

Who We Serve

- Individuals experiencing a mental health crisis.
- Individuals of all ages in Cass, Christian, Logan, Mason, Menard, Morgan, Sangamon and Scott counties.
- MCR operates 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, 365 days a year.
- MCR responds to people regardless of their insurance source and there is no fee.

PSYCHIATRIC RESPONSE TEAM (PRT)

Crisis specialists are based in hospital Emergency Departments (ED) to complete in-person or telehealth crisis screenings. In collaboration with ED staff and Psychiatry, they evaluate individuals presenting to the ED with a mental health concern. PRT will make recommendations for outpatient treatment and referrals as well as inpatient treatment when medically necessary.
