



# **Emergency Medical Services**

- The subsequent slides outline the process for license renewal of the following licenses:
  - Emergency Medical Technician (B, I, P)
  - Lead Instructor
  - Emergency Communications Registered Nurse
  - Emergency Dispatcher
  - First Responder
  - Pre-Hospital Registered Nurse



- It is of the upmost importance that IDPH has your correct address on file.
  - If you need to change your address, you can do so through this webpage:

- Approximately 60 days prior to the expiration of your license, IDPH will mail you a letter to your address listed on file. This form will contain a PIN number and website address.
- Log onto the website and use your PIN number to
  - Pay renewal fees (listed on next slide)
    - Credit or debit card required
  - Declare child support status
  - Declare felony conviction status
- Print Confirmation Page to forward to EMS Office along with continuing education.
- Mailing the paper version to IDPH can be done but will take longer. Forward copy to EMS.



- Renewal Fees
  - Fees range from \$20-\$40
  - Complete fee schedule available through this webpage
  - http://www.idph.state.il.us/ems/forms/EMS Fee Schedule.p df
  - Volunteers serving an area of less than 5,000 population, members of Illinois National Guard and Illinois State Police can apply for a waiver of the fee through this webpage
  - Allow extra time if you apply for this

- Forward the Confirmation Page , current CPR card and CE hour documentation to EMS Coordinator prior to expiration date. In four years the following are required.
  - EMT-B=60 hours
  - EMT-I= 80 hours
  - EMT-P= 100 hours
  - Lead Instructor= 40 hours
  - Emergency Communications RN= 32 hours
  - Emergency Dispatcher= 48 hours
  - First Responder= 24 hours
  - Pre-Hospital RN= 100 hours

# **Region 3 Renewal Requirements**

- Documentation Required
  CPR for Healthcare Provider
- Intermediate/ Paramedic/ PHRN/ECRN
  - ACLS
  - PHTLS, ITLS, TNS or TNCC
  - PEPP, PALS or ENPC
- Additional Information/ Requirements
  - Lead Instructor 40 hours Con Ed and Course Evaluations
  - ECRN 32 hours Con Ed
  - EMD 48 hours Con Ed



- Continuing education hours must include
  - 25% must be within Memorial EMS System
  - No more than 25% from clinical experience (non-paid)
  - No more than 50% from instruction (2hours=1CE hour)
  - Up to 75% can be under one training site code
  - No more than 25% from approved Internet Sites

    - <u>www.MedicEd.com</u> <u>www.healthstream.com</u>
    - <u>www.ems-ce.com</u>
  - Maximum 6 hours CPR



 A 3 month extension will be granted once in the licensee's career. Application is available through this webpage

- Renewals are processed every Monday and Thursday
