Emergency Department (ED) Services for Psychiatric Needs

Every ED is required to have capacity for screening and treating patients needing psychiatric services. There were recent cases where ambulances transported uncooperative, combative psychiatric patients some distance trying to get the patient to a larger center, calling for security to meet them on arrival. In multiple cases there was a hospital closer. In taking the longer transport, the crews are putting themselves into a dangerous situation should it devolve into a more hostile patient situation. Unless a court document is ordering admission at a specific facility, the patient should be transported to the facility of their choice, most likely the one they already use for their medical needs.

National Registry Removes Distributive Education Limits

Following the National Registry Board of Directors meeting on June 15, the board passed 22-Resolution-06, which permanently removes Distributive Education (DE) limits for EMRs, EMTs, AEMTs and Paramedics beginning Sept. 30, 2022. More info can be found <u>here</u>.
