-All providers who do interfacility transport operate under the Interfacility Paramedic or the Expanded Scope Tier I protocols and are required to take yearly competency testing. Providers who tested between Jan 1, 2026 and March 31, 2026, are not required to test again until April of 2027. Providers may test at any of these opportunities. No tests will be started during the last 30 minutes of a testing session.

-Providers may now bring a physical paper copy of the Interfacility Paramedic/Expanded Scope Protocols if they wish to take these tests “open book”.
