

Long Term Post-Op Complications

Gallbladder dysfunction symptoms

(one or all symptoms may occur):

- ▶ Right upper quadrant abdominal pain, epigastric pain, back pain and/or right shoulder pain
- ▶ Nausea/vomiting
- ▶ Fever
- ▶ Bloating
- ▶ Symptoms may occur after eating

If symptoms occur, patient should call to follow up with medical provider.

Internal hernia symptoms

(one or all symptoms may occur):

- ▶ Left upper quadrant pain, typically worse when lying flat and may improve when leaning forward
- ▶ Nausea/vomiting
- ▶ Bloating
- ▶ Changes in bowel habits

If symptoms occur, patient should contact medical provider immediately or seek emergency medical attention.

Ulcer symptoms

(one or all symptoms may occur):

- ▶ Nausea/ vomiting
- ▶ Epigastric pain
- ▶ Heartburn/ reflux
- ▶ Bloating

If symptoms occur, patient should contact medical provider for further work-up and treatment.

Stricture symptoms

(one or all symptoms may occur):

- ▶ Dysphagia (difficulty swallowing food/drinks)
- ▶ Heartburn/reflux
- ▶ Regurgitation of food or liquids

If symptoms occur, patient should contact medical provider for further work-up and treatment.
