Long Term Post-Op Complications

Gallbladder dysfunction symptoms

(one or all symptoms may occur):

- > Right upper quadrant abdominal pain, epigastric pain, back pain and/or right shoulder pain
- Nausea/vomiting
- ► Fever
- Bloating
- > Symptoms may occur after eating

If symptoms occur, patient should call to follow up with medical provider.

Internal hernia symptoms

(one or all symptoms may occur):

- > Left upper quadrant pain, typically worse when lying flat and may improve when leaning forward
- Nausea/vomiting
- Bloating
- Changes in bowel habits

If symptoms occur, patient should contact medical provider immediately or seek emergency medical attention

Ulcer symptoms

(one or all symptoms may occur):

- Nausea/ vomiting
- ▶ Epigastric pain
- Heartburn/ reflux
- Bloating

If symptoms occur, patient should contact medical provider for further work-up and treatment.

Stricture symptoms

(one or all symptoms may occur):

- > Dysphagia (difficulty swallowing food/drinks)
- Heartburn/reflux
- Regurgitation of food or liquids

If symptoms occur, patient should contact medical provider for further work-up and treatment.
