Suspected Homemade Explosive Materials Injury Info

Individuals involved with the making of Homemade Explosive Materials (HME) may present with signs and symptoms of chemical exposure, including chemical burns, respiratory distress and irritation of the eyes and mucous membranes. Potential assessment indicators include, but are not limited to, inconsistent injury explanation, reluctance or evasiveness when questioned and traveling away from the injury site before calling EMS. Environmental indicators when present include, but are not limited to, large quantities of chemicals, plans and formulas, lab equipment, unusual odors and dead grass or foliage. If the patient's story does not match their injuries, the provider should contact law enforcement with their suspicions. The HIPAA privacy rule allows for this good faith reporting.
